

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Experience: The bidder should have executed the similar contract work for two years in the past five years. In case of Category-1, the bidder shall be eligible to submit work experience on par with AC Car/ Bolero Jeep Work order experience for two years in the past five years. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1) The agency / proprietor / partner shall quote their offer per Vehicle in Category-1, 2 & 5 and in case of category-3, 4 & 6, the rate quoted per vehicle shall be applicable for other remaining vehicles in that category.
- 2) The deployment of vehicle will be as per details given in "Scope of Work" indicated in NIT.
- 3) Normal usage of the vehicle under Singrauli Region local use deployed as per Contract (Except Project) on weekday i.e., Monday to Saturday, however, the vehicle if required on Sundays and Holidays shall also be provided by the Contractor. Normally two days in a month (Sundays & Holidays only) will be provided as off-day for maintenance and other requirements. Whereas the usage of the vehicle in the Projects / Site Offices, is for all seven days of the week, and whenever regular vehicle withdrawn for maintenance etc. the contractor shall provide alternate vehicle as a replacement.
- 4) The vehicles owned by BEML Employees and / or their dependents / Blood relatives (Either by owner or by Driver) should not deployed at BEML on contract to be made from this tender. If any contravention of this clause is noticed during the pendency of the contract, the contract will be terminated immediately and the EMD (in case in the contravention is noticed before submission of Security Deposit) or Security Deposit (in case in the contravention is noticed after submission of Security Deposit) will be forfeited.
- 5) The agency will do periodical maintenance of the vehicles to avoid breakdown. The agency has to inform the concerned official in BEML one day before the maintenance of vehicle. In case the vehicle breaks down on the way, the agency will have to pay actual fare to the officials up to the place of destination. Further the agency should arrange similar substitute vehicle till original vehicle is restored.
- 6) The agency shall change the driver if not found suitable or desirable by the officials and make immediate arrangements to provide a substitute driver. The same should be communicated immediately to BEML. If the driver proceeds on leave for whatsoever reasons, the agency shall provide substitute driver without delay.
- 7) The Driver of the vehicle should have minimum of 5 years/ experience, physically fit, having good eyesight and reflexes. Driver should be aware of the localities and routes within the place of deployment.
- 8) Driver should have knowledge of commonly spoken language Hindi and knowledge of Local & English languages will be preferred. The driver shall not smoke cigarettes / bidis nor use other tobacco products while on duty. The driver shall not spit and make unsavory gestures while performing duty. The driver shall not use mobile phone while driving, and calls, if any shall be attended only by stopping the vehicle at suitable location.
- 9) Drivers shall wear preferably white or Khakhi uniform both the trousers and shirts while on duty. While deployed for duty, the driver should be courteous to the passengers and well behaved. The driver shall open and close the doors for all the passengers while getting into and getting out of the vehicles.
- 10) The driver will comply with the orders given by the officials of BEML regarding safety and security even when the vehicle is parked in the office /project / mining area and BEML will not in any way be responsible for the safety & security of the vehicle.

11)The driver shall not consume alcohol and shall not be under the influence of alcohol while on duty, and if noticed it will attract penalty as determined by BEML and may lead to cancellation of contract, if such occurrence is repeated.

- 12) The vehicle driver should always carry photo Identity Cards issued by the successful bidder (Contractor / Agency). Such Identity Cards will be countersigned by the Authorized Officer of BEML Limited.
- 13)The vehicle must be kept clean and to be provided with neat seat covers of good material, which should be changed periodically. If not provided penalty will be recovered from the respective monthly bills. Agency shall bear the expenses with regard to washing of seat cover and general upkeep of the vehicle.
- **14)** The applicant firm shall be having a running office **at Singrauli**. The agency should maintain a record of the running of the vehicles on daily basis, which should be countersigned by the concerned officials in the respective logbook.
- 15)Proper LOG BOOK will have to be provided by the Contractor for each of the vehicle where the running KM of the vehicle, Date & Time, Purpose of use of vehicle and signature of the user of vehicle will recorded. The driver has to ensure its proper filling and acknowledgement while performing the duty. The Vehicle LOG BOOK details as recorded and signed by the user will be the basis for preparing the bills and tampering / overwritten KM. or timing by the Driver if not countersigned by the user will attract deduction accordingly.
- 16)In usual course, the kilometer & time opening and closing will be reckoned from the respective locations mentioned above as per the contract.
- 17)BEML Ltd reserves the right to check the speedometer / odometer of the deployed vehicle at any point of time and if it is found inaccurate / tampered, suitable action deemed fit will be taken.
- 18) The contractor shall make his own arrangements for rest room / change room or lunch / dinner room for the Drivers.
- 19)In case of not reporting/delay in reporting at the place of duty assigned **penalty will be imposed to the extent of Rs.750/- per day** which will be deducted from monthly bills.
- 20)In the event of non deployment of a vehicle a stand by vehicle shall be provided by the contractor or else another vehicle will be hired from the market, the actual charges of which will be recovered from the contractor's bill. Apart from penalty charged for the inconvenience caused, no payment shall be made for running of the vehicle on the date.
- 21)In the event of replacement of the vehicle provided, prior intimation should be given to the concerned officer. However, replacement should be done in consultation with the officer concerned.
- 22)In case of any accident or breakdown of vehicle the agency should attend the formalities with the Traffic Police/RTO authorities including court proceedings and claims thereon under the Motor Vehicle Act, if any, as the case may be. In such an event, an alternative transport arrangement should be made by the contractor or agency at his cost within one hour from the time of accident/breakdown beyond which the actual cost of any alternative arrangements made by BEML shall be at the cost of the agency.
- 23)In the event of absence from duty by the driver for receiving any official at the Railway station or at any requisite point due to negligence of the driver, the agency shall have to bear the actual expenses

incurred for making alternative arrangement. Apart from penalty charged for the inconvenience caused, no payment shall be made for running of the vehicle on the date.

- 24)The agency and the driver should have a contact point for 24 hours and the telephone/cell numbers shall be provided at the time of signing contract. Any subsequent changes in address or phone number of the agency or driver; the same shall be intimated promptly in writing within 24 hours.
- 25)The agency should make arrangement for filling diesel with the pumping station which is on the regular route or otherwise the extra running for filling of diesel and any use of the vehicle by the driver will be at the cost of the agency.

- 37) The Tenderer shall read and understand the Scope of work, Special terms and conditions, General terms and conditions and other conditions of the tender before submitting the tender for this work and shall agree to abide by the terms and conditions outlined above and these documents shall form part and parcel of the contract awarded to the Contractor.
- 38) The contractor shall be deemed to have studied the scope of work thoroughly before offering of their rates to complete awarded work for supply of Vehicles as per the requirements of BEML Regional Office, Singrauli. The Contractor shall visit the site before offering his rates, if necessary.
- 39) The tender forms Part-I, Part-II, Annexure A, B, C, D and E duly filled in all respects shall be signed on each page by the bidder and upload on BEML SRM collaboration folder in the system. All entries in the tender document should be in one ink (only in Blue Ball pen). Any Corrections, over writing, etc., should be avoided and alteration, if any, neatly carried out and duly attested over with the full signature of the Bidder, however, is permitted. All the columns in the tender form should be filled without leaving any column blank in any page of the tender. In case any of the columns are left blank, the tender can be rejected and unrelated Column should be marked as "NA".
- 40) BEML Ltd reserves the right to assess the capacity and capability of the parties for pre-qualification. M/s BEML Ltd. Also reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders or any part thereof at any stage of process without assigning any reason whatsoever. The offer of the Bidder if prima-facie found not comparable with the quantum of work envisaged and the bid is an effort to become L1, then the offer is liable to be rejected. BEML Ltd decision in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 41) If the L1 bidder does not offer for full quantity of vehicle required as per NIT, the negotiated rate with L1 Party shall be counter offered to the other bidders (subsequent to L1) equal to less the number of vehicles offered by L1 bidder, than total no of vehicles required as per NIT. BEML Ltd reserves the right to award the contract to one or more contractors simultaneously as deemed fit at the initial stage or during the contract period.
- 42) **SUBLETTING / SUBCONTRACT**: The Contractor shall not assign or make over the contract to any other person or underlet it or make a subcontract with any person / firms for the execution of any of work.
- 43) The tenderer shall agree, not to petition for revision of rates tendered by him under any circumstances at any stage of work either during execution or when the final claim is settled.
- 44) For any default/mistake in the bills/incomplete bills the same will be returned to the agency for necessary corrections.
- 45) Any damage or loss caused by the driver of the contractor to BEML property/ Machineries, equipments, moveable / non moveable assets etc., the cost towards such damages / loss as assessed by BEML will be recovered from the amount due to the Contractor.
- 46) Any written communication required to be sent to the contractor shall be sent at the address mentioned on the tender form or to any other address subsequently intimated by contractor in writing to BEML Ltd for the subject contract purposes.

47) The bidders should note that the Income Tax and other statutory payments as applicable from time to time will be deducted from the bills of contractor.

- 48) The contractor shall ensure that all the rules of the Company concerning discipline, safety, security and conduct are observed by his staff while working. In case of any non compliance, the contractor shall be responsible for the consequence.
- 49) **Execution of Agreement:** Successful bidders shall enter into an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 500/- as a token of having accepted the rates, terms and conditions of the contract as per the pro-forma given by BEML Ltd. The effective date of the contract shall be reckoned from the date of signing the contract.
- 50) **Compliance of Labour Law**: During continuance of the contract, the contractor shall abide at all times by all existing labour enactments and rules made there under, regulations, notifications and bye laws of the Central Government and any other labour law, including rules, regulations, bye laws that may be passed or notification that may be issued under any labour law in further by the Central Government. The contractor shall keep the Employer indemnified in case any action is taken against the Employer by the competent authority on account of contravention of any of the provisions of any Act or rules made there under, regulations or notifications including amendments. If the Employer is caused to pay or reimburse such amounts as may be necessary to cause or observe, or for non-observance of the provisions stipulated in the notifications bye laws/acts/rules/regulations/including amendments, if any on the part of the contractor, the Employer shall have the right to deduct any money due to the contractor including his amount of security deposit. The Employer shall also have right to recover from the contractor any sum required or estimated to be required for making good the loss or damage suffered by the Employer. - 52) **VALIDITY:** The validity period of the tenders shall be 6(six) months from the date of opening of Part-I bid. The tenderer shall not, during the said period or within the period extended by mutual consent, revoke or cancel his tender or vary the tender on any terms thereof without consent in writing of the company. In case the tenderer violates to abide by this, the Company will be entitled to forfeit the Earnest Money and reject the tender.
- 53) Management of M/s. BEML Ltd., reserves the right to add, amend, alter, delete any of the above conditions or seek any additional documents / information and to terminate the agreement by giving one month notice. However, on account of unsatisfactory performance of the contractor, the contract can be terminated with or without notice with or without assigning any reasons.
- 54) All disputes are subject to jurisdiction of Waidhan/Singrauli court only.
- 55) Canvassing/influencing in any form by the bidders, including receipt of unsolicited covers or post tender corrections shall be rejected without any notice to the bidder.

56) **ARBITRATION:**

For PSUs: In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the 22rovisions of this Agreement, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either party for Arbitration to the Sole Arbitrator in Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the Secretary to the Government of India, in charge of the Department of Public Enterprises. The Arbitration and Conciliation Act,1996 shall not be applicable to the arbitration under this clause. The award of the Arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such Award may make further reference for setting aside or revision of the Award to the Law Secretary, Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference, the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary/Addl. Secretary, when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties finally and conclusively. The parties to the dispute will share equally the cost of Arbitration as intimated by the Arbitrator.

57) FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Contract, neither the Supplier nor the Purchaser shall be held responsible for total or partial non-execution of any of the contractual obligations, should the obligation become unreasonably onerous or impossible due to occurrence of a 'Force Majeure' conditions which directly affect the obligations to be performed by the Purchaser or the Supplier. Such events include war, military operations of any nature, blockages, revolutions, insurrections, riots, civil commotions, insurgency, sabotage, acts of public enemy, fires, explosion, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, floods, earthquake, or acts of God, restrictions by Govt. authorities over which the Supplier or the acts on which the Purchaser has no control.

The party claiming to be affected by Force Majeure shall notify the other party in writing without delay, within two weeks on the intervention and on the cessation of such circumstance. Extension of time sought by the Supplier along with supporting evidence and so granted by the Purchaser for the supply/ work affected, if any, shall not be construed as waiver in respect of remaining deliveries.

Notwithstanding above provisions, Purchaser shall reserve the right to cancel the order/ Contract, wholly or partly, in order to meet the overall delivery schedule and make alternative arrangements including arrangements with third party for completion of deliveries and other schedules. Purchaser may takeover partly processed material at a mutually agreed price.

58) APPLICABLE LAWS AND JURISDICTION OF COURTS:

Indian laws both substantive and procedural, for the time being in force including modifications thereto, shall govern Contract. The competent Indian courts shall have sole jurisdiction over disputes between purchaser and the Supplier.

59) INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS; LICENSES:

If any Patent design, trademark or any other intellectual property rights apply to the delivery or accompanying documentation, Purchaser shall be entitled to the legal use thereof free of charge by means of a non-exclusive, worldwide, perpetual license. All intellectual property rights that arise due to the execution of the delivery by the Supplier and by its employees or third parties involved by the Supplier for performance of the agreement belong to Purchaser.

The Supplier shall be obligated to do everything necessary to obtain or establish the above mentioned rights. The Supplier guarantees that the delivery does not infringe on any of the intellectual property rights of third parties. "The Supplier shall comply with all applicable Labor Laws, particularly ESI Act, Gratuity Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Contract Labour (R&A) Act1970, Employee's Compensation Act, Payment of Minimum Wages Act, Provident Fund Act etc., and Rules framed therein from time –to- time and the Supplier shall indemnify the Company for any loss caused to it by reason of inaction, non-compliance etc., of the provisions of any Law by the Supplier".

60) BRIBES AND GIFTS:

Any bribe, commissions, gift or advantage given, promised or offered by or on behalf of the supplier or his partner, agent or servant or anyone on his or on their behalf to any officer, servant, representative or agent of BEML or any person on his or their behalf in relation to the obtaining or to the execution of or any other contract with BEML Ltd., shall in addition to any criminal liability which the supplier , may incur, subject the supplier to the cancellation of this and all other contracts with BEML and also for payment of any loss or damage resulting from any such cancellation to like extent, the supplier shall be liable for any loss which BEML may sustain on that account. Any question or dispute as to the commissions of any offence under the present clause shall be settled by BEML in such manner and on such evidence of information as they may think fit and sufficient and their decision shall be final and conclusive.

61)JURISDICTION:

Courts at Dhanbadlone shall have jurisdiction to decide any issue/dispute arising out of the Arbitration or this Purchase Order in exclusion of all other Courts. However, jurisdiction of any other court may be accepted by mutual discussion and agreement by and between the Company and the Supplier.

62) DRAWINGS AND DOCUMENTS:

Drawings, technical documents or other technical information received by one party shall not, without the consent of the other party, be used for any other purpose than that for which they were provided. They may not, without the consent of the submitting party, otherwise be used or copied, reproduced, transmitted or communicated to third parties.

The Supplier shall, as per agreed date/s but not later than the date of delivery, provide free of charge information and drawings which are necessary to permit the Purchaser to erect, commission, operate and maintain the product. All intellectual properties, including designs,

drawings and product information etc. exchanged during the formation and execution of the Contract shall continue to be the property of the submitting party.

66)CONTRACT VARIATIONS: INCREASE OR DECREASE IN THE SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

Purchaser may vary the contracted scope. If the supplier is of the opinion that the variation in scope has an effect on the agreed price or delivery period, purchaser shall be informed of this immediately in writing along with technical details, and in the event of additional work, submit a quotation with regards to the price and delivery period and the effect this scope will have on the other contracts under execution by the supplier. The supplier shall not perform additional work/ altered scope of work without the written instructions/amendment to the Purchase Order to that effect. The Purchaser also reserves its rights to decrease the scope of supply placed against Purchase Orders under due intimation to the supplier. Such decrease may be warranted due to defective goods or Policy Decisions of the Management of the Purchaser. And in such an event, the Supplier shall not have any claims or right against the Purchaser.

67)NON-WAIVER OF DEFAULTS:

If any individual provision of the Contract is invalid the other provisions shall not be affected. The failure of BEML to insist upon performance of the Contract, to enforce any of the terms and conditions of this Contract or to exercise any right or privilege granted to BEML under this Contract or under law, shall not be construed as a waiver and the same shall continue in full force and effect.

68) ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS; SUBCONTRACTING:

The supplier is not permitted to subcontract the delivery or any part thereof to third parties or to assign the rights and obligations resulting from this agreement in whole or in part to third parties without prior written permission from Purchaser. Any permission or approval given by the Purchaser shall, however, not absolve the supplier of the responsibility of his obligations under the contract.

69) INTEGRITY COMMITMENT IN THE EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS:

34.1. Commitment by Purchaser:

Purchaser commits to take all necessary steps to prevent corruption in connection with the execution of the Contract.
