# Activities involved

### Wages, PF & ESI:

I. The Applicable Minimum wages including revision of Minimum wages as notified by Central Government from time to time, during the contract period and in addition Annual Leave with wages (Un availed Earned Leave), payment of National & Festival Holidays & Bonus will be borne by BEML. The prevailing rate w.e.f. 01.10.2019 of Minimum Wages are as under:

- II. **Overtime wages**: No personnel shall be allowed to deploy on overtime work, No continuous shift in a day on whatsoever circumstances. The contractor/agency should deploy the personnel only for 8 hours per day. Due to unavoidable circumstances if any personnel deployed on overtime work/on holiday duty/on weekly day of rest, then the contractor/agency shall pay the overtime wages as per the provisions of factories Act and rules made there under / any other applicable rules and BEML shall not reimburse the above said payment.
- III. **Working days:** 26 days in a month (Reliever to be provided for shortfall days). No separate reliever charges will be paid.

Due to exigencies, on Sundays/ Holidays if any, the contractor shall deploy as per the direction given by user dept from time to time, such deployment will be adjusted against the total mandays supposed to be supplied by the contractor in a month

- IV. On verification of acquaintance rolls, payment for services charges, deducting TDS applicable on gross amount payable to contractor as per prevailing rates, will be released through RTGS / NIFT.
- V. Frequent change of deployed workmen will not be allowed, considering the training and safety aspects in mining projects.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### 1. Meaning of terms used in this NIT :

#### 1.1 CONTRACTOR

Shall mean the Firm whose offer has been **accepted by BEML** and the term includes the contractor's authorized representative, successors, heirs, assignee, executors and administrators, unless excluded by the contract.

#### **1.2 SUB-CONTRACTOR**

Means the person/firm named in the contract/ Work order for executing the work or any persons/firm to whom any part of the contract /work order has been given by the contractor, subject to the prior **consent given by BEML** in writing and the term includes the sub-contractors authorised representative, successors and assignees.

## 1.3 PROJECT – IN –CHARGE.

Means the person appointed for the duties set forth in the contract/ work order on its behalf and whose authority is notified, in writing to the contractor by BEML.

## **1.4 CONTRACT**

Means written agreement between **BEML LIMITED** AND **CONTRACTOR/FIRM** made from time to time.

## 2. SAFETY AND SAFETY EQUIPMENTS.

- 1. Knowledge of Safety rules and regulations and ensuring their implementations and the availability of Safety Equipments, like safety gloves, safety shoes, safety goggles, safety caps (helmets), first aid boxes and welding, cutting & grinding equipment. The contractor shall adhere to various other Safety aspects as required. Contractor's workman should observe and follow the safety & DGMS regulation applicable at site during the above work. The contractor's workman should have VTC. Contractor should ensure necessary gate passes for his work men.
- 2. Necessary safety equipment like safety shoes, helmets, etc to be provided to technical manpower deployed by the service provider.

# 3. SECURITY

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to safeguard, safe handling, safe custody and safe protection of the equipments, tools & tackles. Safe custody of the tools, Accommodation and transportation of contractor's workman etc. will be contractor's responsibility.

- **4. Offer Validity** : The offered price shall be valid for 6(Six) months from the date of tender closing.
- 5. INSURANCE OF PERSONNEL ENGAGES BY CONTRACTOR:
  - It shall be the Contractors responsibility to arrange for insurance cover for

all the personnel engaged in repair job and related Equipments. The 11 | P a g e

insurance should also cover third party liabilities. In all cases of exigencies, such as the workers falling sick, accident during the course of work, the contractor shall bear all expenses on his own account and the company shall have no liability on behalf of contractor. Any injury to workmen during the course of work will be totally firm's responsibility and BEML will have no responsibility whatsoever in this regard

Any injury to workmen during the course of work will be totally firms responsibility and BEML will have no responsibility whatsoever in this regard.

### 6. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. The job has to be done in such a manner that, there is no injury/damage caused to the persons working and no damage should occur to the parts while working on the machines.
- 2. Any injury to workmen during the course of work will be totally your responsibility and BEML will have no responsibility whatsoever in this regard.
- 3. You are required to observe and follow the safety regulation applicable at site during the above work. The firm has to arrange VTC for the personnel working on site as per the DGMS guide lines. The **list of manpower** to be deployed have to be **submitted to projects in advance at least 15 days** for VTC and gate pass.
- 4. You should ensure necessary gate passes for the work men as per mines norms.
- 5. Necessary safety equipment like safety shoes, helmets, etc to be provided to man power deployed by the service provider.

### 7. PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITION:

- The successful contractor has to pay wages to all contract personnel on or before 7<sup>th</sup> of every month compulsorily.
   BEML will release payment to the contractor against submission of GST tax invoice (along with PF Statement/ ESI Statement/ Wage slips/ Bank statement) to the Regional office Bilaspur for arranging payment.
- > TDS will be recovered from the running bills as per the IT act.
- The contractor shall also make payment of minimum bonus as applicable under Payment of Bonus Act every year which will be reimbursed by BEML.
- On verification of acquaintance rolls (Attendance certified by project Service In-charge), payment for services charges, deducting TDS applicable on gross amount payable to contractor as per prevailing rates, will be released through RTGS / NIFT.

8. COMPLIANCE OF PREVAILING STATE RULES: On receipt of the contract/work order, the contractor shall register as per WORKS CONTRACT ACT or any other prevailing rules in that state, with the concerned state government to comply with the labour laws and rules, mobilize required manpower and other infrastructure as required.

**9.** BEML Reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of manpower at the same price, terms & conditions during the pendency of the contract.

### 10. CONFIDENTIAL CLAUSE.

The contractor shall use all technical information, drawings and other advices / information provided by BEML only for execution of this contract. The contractor shall not pass on any data, material or information or drawings to other agency or use for any other purpose.

#### **11. WAGES FOR WORKMEN AND WORKMEN COMPENSATION**

#### a) WAGES FOR WORKMEN.

It will be the obligation of the contractor to pay central Govt. minimum wages to the workmen employed by them. However, such wages shall not be less than the wages payable under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 or the wages notified by the respective State/central Governments who are the concerned authorities for notifying the minimum wages payable to the workmen possessing different skills and who are engaged in executing the contract .The contractor shall also be bound by the statutory provisions of the Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act, Apprentices Act, PSU Act, PF ACT etc., concerning the employment of the Labour by the contractor. All the obligations under the different Act provisions shall be that of the contractor and the contractor shall indemnify BEML against any or all claims in this regard.

#### **b. WORKMEN COMPENSATION**

It is also agreed that BEML shall not be liable for any compensation to be payable in respect of any workmen employed by the contractor and it shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor for payment of compensation if any, arising during the course of execution of the contract. For this purpose, the contractor shall indemnify BEML during the period of the contract against all such claims made by any person(s) employed by the contractor in execution of the contract.

BEML shall not be responsible for providing employment to contractor's labourers and or payment of any retrenchment benefits, and it shall be the duty and responsibility of the contractor to pay all terminal benefits at the time of completion of contract and shall produce satisfactory proof for having paid so, before the final bill is settled.

# 12.Determination of lowest bidder (L-1)

Total Financial Impact of service charges for total personnel per day (i.e. sum of service charges for 06 highly skilled plus sum of service charges of 08 skilled) will be taken to arrive the lowest bidder for awarding contract.

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Example: party A - Service Charges for Highly skilled / day per labor - Rs. 10.
Service Charges for skilled / day per labor - Rs. 5.
Total for Party A – (10X6 + 5X8 )= Rs. 100/-
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party B - Service Charges for Highly skilled / day per labor - Rs. 12.
Service Charges for skilled / day per labor - Rs. 4.
Total for Party A – (12X6 + 4X8 )= Rs. 104/-
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From above Party A will L-1 Bidder.

# 13. Evaluation of Bids

Technical bid will be opened on payment towards EMD and Tender fee, then the technical evaluation of those bids will be carried out and Price bids of such agencies / firms whose technical bids are qualified as per tender terms, will be opened for further processing.

# **14. SUSPENSION OF WORK**

The contractor shall on written order of the Project—in—charge (BEML), suspend the progress of the works or any part thereof for such time or times and in such manner as the Project—in—Charge (BEML) may consider necessary and shall during such suspension properly protect and secure the work, so far as is necessary in his opinion.

# 15. Penalty:

The successful contractor has to provide manpower as specified in the work order continuously for 26 working days in a month, failing which an amount of Rs. 100/- will be levied as penalty per person for absent days if per day deployed persons

are less than 12 and amount will be recovered in monthly bills.

## **16. ASSIGNMENT SUB-LETTING AND SUB-CONTRACTING**

The contractor shall not assign the contact either wholly or part thereof or any benefit or interest therein or there under without the prior written approval of BEML. The contractor shall not sublet the whole / part of the contract. However, where otherwise provided in the contract/work order the contractor may sublet a part of the contract with prior approval of BEML. But such an approval if given shall not relieve the contractor of any of the liabilities and obligations under the contract and he shall be responsible for the acts defaults and neglects of the subcontractor, his agents or workmen.

## **17. INDEMNITY**

The contractor shall indemnify BEML at all times against all claims made by the contractors personnel and third parties in respect of any injuries accidents or any other claim in the form of compensation.

### **18. FORCE MAJEURE**

The contractor shall not be responsible for any delay in execution of this contract if the delay is caused as a result of Force Majeure.

"Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Contractor, such as Floods, wars or revolutions, epidemics, strikes (caused by other than contractors own employees/ workmen), terrorist attack etc.

**19.** Force-Closure of Contract: If at any time after acceptance of the tender/contract BEML decide to abandon or reduce the scope of work for any reason whatsoever, Regional Manager, RO, Bilaspur shall give notice in

writing to that effect to the Contractor. The compensation if any payable for such foreclosure of work will be discussed mutually between BEML and the contractor and settled after taking into consideration the loss suffered by the Contractor on account of foreclosure of the contract. The Contractors shall have no claim to any payment of compensation or otherwise, whatsoever, on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived consequent on foreclosure of the whole or part of the works.

## **20. ARBITRATION CLAUSE**

If BEML and the contractor are not able to resolve any contract dispute amicably within a reasonable period of time, such disputes shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by BEML and the proceedings before the Arbitrator shall be governed by the provisions of Arbitrations and conciliation Act 1996, in which event the Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Bangalore and the Arbitrator shall be required to give a reasoned award. Courts in Bangalore alone shall have jurisdiction in the matter.
